



### **Going Cuckoo**



Each year beginning on January 11, fans of the comedic duo of Stan Laurel and Oliver Hardy celebrate Cuckoo Dancing Week in

honor of Laurel and Hardy's Cuckoo theme song. Marvin Hatley first composed the tune known as "The Dance of the Cuckoos" as an onthe-hour musical chime for the Hal Roach Studio's radio station in 1930. When Laurel heard the tune, he asked Hatley if he and Hardy could use it in their act. Laurel thought the tune perfectly captured their characters: pompous and dramatic for Hardy, while discordant and goofy for Laurel. The duo's slapstick comedy routines, featured in over

100 short films and features, gave Laurel and Hardy worldwide fame. And everywhere Laurel and Hardy went, "The Dance of the Cuckoos" followed. When they visited Ireland in 1953, the church bells of Cork's Cobh Cathedral rang out "The Dance of the Cuckoos" to welcome them.


